Primarily this decrease is from Capital Projects in 2017 Budget of \$880,000 not included in 2018 Budget. Salary and Wages increased \$15,000 (11.7%) due to increases not included in previous years budget for Admin Asst and Clerk for cost of living. Commissioners increased \$8,000 (26.7%) Commissioner's have not increased this expense in several years and are bringing it up to cost of living increases. Both expenses increase Fringe Benefits \$32,281 (16.5%) for Employer Taxes and added Group Life Ins of \$25,000 (100%). Utilities increased \$15,500 (12.4%) part of a new rental agreement not including utilities. Election increased \$1,000 (33%) for added rental equipment expenses. Dues increased \$3,000 (40%) due to additional NFPA subscription. Office expenses increased \$2,450 (24%) due to added office expenses for ink/toner. Office Cleaning increased \$16,500 (100%) this account was added to unburden the office staff. Training and Education decreased \$9,700 (-43%) since they do not anticipate many volunteers going to the annual Expo in 2018. Personal Protective Equipment increased \$25,000 (34%) this was to add gear for new volunteer members and replenish outdated gear. Communications equipment decreased \$27,000 (-31%) due to purchases for radios made in 2017.

The amount to be raised by taxation is increasing \$11,643 (.6%). The tax rate will not increase. The district is utilizing \$243,000 (13%) of Unrestricted Surplus Funds to balance the budget. This will have no impact on the 2019 Budget.

The 2018 Budget is in compliance with the levy cap.

EAST BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT NO.1 FIRE PROTECTION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT dated this <u>lst</u> day of <u>March</u>, 2016 by and between the Board of Fire Commissioners Fire District No. 1 Township of East Brunswick, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey hereinafter designated as the "Board", and the Old Bridge Volunteer Fire Company hereinafter designated as the "Company".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS; the Board of Fire Commissioners, is a duly constituted public agency organized pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:14-70 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS; N.J.S.A. 40A:14-70.1.b. authorizes the Board of Fire Commissioners to contract with a volunteer fire company for the purpose of providing fire protection services upon such terms and conditions as shall be deemed proper; and

WHEREAS; the Company is a duly constituted nonprofit corporation organized pursuant to the laws of the State of New Jersey for the purpose of providing fire suppression/fire protection services; and

WHEREAS; the parties hereto desire to enter into a contract to define the rights, duties and responsibilities of each regarding the furnishing of fire protection services to the residents of the fire district.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES AND COVENANTS CONTAINED HEREIN IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. TERM: This Agreement shall have a one year duration commencing on March 1, 2016 and terminating, unless otherwise renewed and extended, on February 28, 2017.
- 2. <u>DUTIES</u>: The Company covenants and agrees to provide fire protection/fire suppression services to all persons and property situate within the borders of Fire District No.1 East Brunswick Township, Middlesex County, New Jersey and to

provide said fire services seven (7) days per week, twenty four (24) hours per day, in accordance with any and all applicable rules, regulations, standards and laws of the State of New Jersey and any administrative agency having the necessary and proper jurisdiction to prescribe rules and regulations regarding the conduct of fire fighting services. The Company shall operate and utilize any and all equipment and apparatus supplied by the Board for the purposes of fire suppression in accordance with such rules and regulations as may be adopted by the Board. The Company shall provide such personnel as may be available for the purposes specified herein. The members of the Company shall operate under the supervision and control of the Board and in performing fire duty shall be deemed to be exercising a governmental function.

- Commissioners the right to use and occupy the premises and building commonly known as the Fire Commissioners Office located at 680 Old Bridge Tumpike. for its administrative offices and the firehouses located on Pine Street, Fern Road and the Civic Center in East Brunswick Township for the storage and maintenance of fire apparatus and equipment; the conduct of public meetings, both public and executive sessions; and generally to use the buildings for the conduct of Fire District business including use as polling places for such elections as may be required to be held within the District, subject only to the requirement that the Commissioners notify the Company in advance of their intention to use the buildings for such purposes and also subject to the requirement that such use will not interfere with normal operations of the fire company.
- 4. <u>CONSIDERATION</u>: The Board shall pay the Company, as and for consideration for the promises and covenants contained herein, the sum of THREE HUNDRED ELEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$311,000.00)

per annum for the duration of this agreement. Said consideration shall be payable in equal monthly installments. All monies paid pursuant to the terms of this Agreement shall be used for the usual and customary expenses incidental to the operations of a volunteer fire company and may not be used in any manner that could be construed as individual personal gain.

4A. 680 OLD BRIDGE TURNPIKE RENT: In addition to the sum specified in Paragraph 4. above, the Board shall pay the Company, as rent for the use and occupancy

of the building and premises located at 680 Old Bridge Turnpike, Twelve THOUSAND DOLLARS AND no/00------, ier annum. Rent payments shall be due and payable in 12 equal monthly installments in the amount of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS PER MONTH (\$1,000.00)

- 5. MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR: The Commissioners shall be responsible for the payment of all costs for the maintenance and repair of all fire fighting equipment and apparatus supplied by it to the Company in accordance with the budget adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners at the annual referendum.
- individual members of the Volunteer Fire Company, such insurance as may be legally required, including but not limited to workers compensation, motor vehicle insurance relating to the use of fire district owned apparatus and equipment and life insurance as permitted by statute. The Board shall also provide, and keep in full force for the benefit of the Company, comprehensive liability insurance insuring the Company against any and all claims or liability arising out of or in connection with the provisions of firefighting services or resulting from any accident or occurrence in or about the buildings and premises described above. The limits of said policy shall be not less than \$1,000,000.00 for injuries to one person and \$3,000,000.00 for injuries to more than one person, in any one accident or occurrence, and for loss or damage to the property of any person or persons, for not less than \$3,000,000.00. The Board shall also provide general hazard and fire insurance for the above described premises in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.00 naming the Company as an additional insured.
- 7. ANNUAL ACCOUNTING: The Company shall provide an annual accounting of all public monles received and expenditures made by it to the Board.
- this Agreement are contingent upon the approval of the annual budget of the Board by the voters of Fire District No.1 as provided by statute. In the event the budget is not approved for any year during the term of this Agreement, or in the event that the Township of East Brunswick does not make the quarterly payment of tax revenues required by statute, the payments due the Company shall be suspended and tolled without penalty, until the budget is fixed by the Township Committee as required by statute.

9. SAVINGS CLAUSE: The terms and provisions of this Agreement are subject to such limitations as may be imposed upon either of the parties by statute or ordinance. Should any provision of this Agreement be ruled invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such ruling, shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have caused this Agreement to be executed by their duly authorized officers and representatives on this 1stday of March 2016.

The Township advanced a check in the sum of \$750,000.00 to Fire District #1. These funds were requested as part of the Shared Service Agreement between Township of East Brunswick and Fire District #1. Fire District #1 is to purchase one custom built triple combination Class "A" Pumper, as approved by district voters.

The first year's interest was \$3,000.00 (0.4%), plus cost of issuance \$975 for a total amount due of \$111,975.

The second year's payment was \$2,880 (0.45%) interest, plus cost of issuance \$1,444.00, plus principal of \$108,000 for a total amount due of \$112,324.00.

The third year's payment (2017) is an interest of \$1,068 (0.20%), plus cost of issuance at \$471.00 and a principal of \$108,000 for a total amount due of \$109,539.

Year 2018, you can see the interest reflects what the Fed's are doing by increasing rates. The interest is 1.19%, but the 2018 payment will be adjusted by Resolution #16204 attached. This change is the result of your request for a longer payback time.
