The 2019 Budget is increasing \$255,898 (+10.7%). Primarily this increase is from Capital Appropriations increasing \$190,000 (+211.1%) Interest on Investments increased \$2,000 (+66.7%) based on current historic data. Supplemental Fire Service Act decreased \$1,004 (-15.8%) based on the current year receipt of service. Admin Fringe-Group Life increased \$31,000 (+124%) due to increased volunteers. Building and Repairs increased \$15,000 (+25%) due to aging apparatus and increase repairs. Rental of Office Equipment increased \$6,000 (+50%) due do an increase in need for new coper and computer. Professional Fees increased \$6,000 (50%) due to additional legal fees needed in 2019. Haz Mat Spills Material Supplies was decreases \$500 (-100%) since it was combined in another line item. Training and Education increased \$8,000 (+63%) for additional attendance to Annual Expos.

The amount to be raised by taxation is increasing \$17.902 (+.9%). The tax rate is increasing to \$.289 The district is utilizing \$480,000 (31%) of Unrestricted Surplus Funds for Capital Appropriations and to meet the 2019 budget.

The 2019 Budget is in compliance with the levy cap.

These funds were requested as part of the Shared Service Agreement between Township of East Brunswick and Fire District #1. Fire District #1 is to purchase one custom built triple combination Class "A" Pumper, as approved by district voters.

The first year's interest was \$3,000.00 (0.4%), plus cost of issuance \$975 for a total amount due of \$111,975.

The second year's payment was \$2,880 (0.45%) interest, plus cost of issuance \$1,444.00, plus principal of \$108,000 for a total amount due of \$112,324.00.

The third year's payment (2017) is an interest of \$1,068 (0.20%), plus cost of issuance at \$471.00 and a principal of \$108,000 for a total amount due of \$109,539.

The forth year's payment was \$5,069.40 (1.19%) interest, plus cost of issuance \$426.00, plus principal of \$71,000 for a total amount due of \$76,495.40

Year 2019, the interest is \$5,680.00 (1.60%), plus cost of issuance \$230.50, plus principal of \$71,000 for a total amount due of \$76,910.50 due January 11, 2019.
